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Who does not need to meet the new rules?

Many people qualify for an exclusion or exception, including those who:

- Are pregnant now or were pregnant within the last 12 months
- Care for young children or a person who is disabled
- Are disabled or living with certain health conditions
- Meet TANF work requirements
- Are a member of a household that gets SNAP and are not exempt from SNAP work requirements
